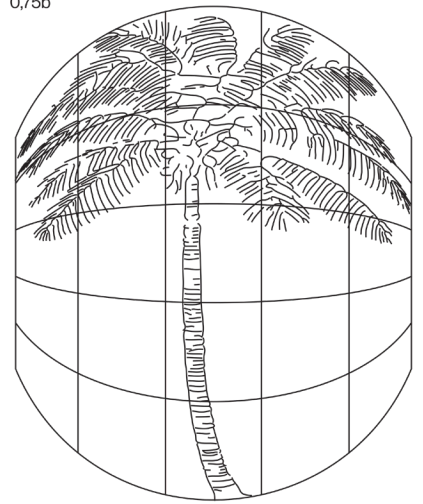


Welcome to S1

In addition, we aim to become a holistic entity – an educational and research institute – run by artists for artists.



Accessibility

If you have difficulty accessing our space, please ask our staff and we will gladly help you. The entrance is up six steps. The space is at this moment not accessible for wheelchair users. If the door happens to be locked, you can ring the bell that is placed right above the door handle. Dogs are allowed inside if on a leash for the safety of any exhibited sculptures and objects. The closest tram stop is Divadlo pod Palmovkou or Palmovka. The nearest metro is yellow line B, station Palmovka where is an elevator available. Both entry and events are free of charge, although for some events you have to sign up beforehand. We ask visitors to come fragrance-free as we try to reduce scents in the space to accommodate people with chemical sensitivity. Our space has 11 fluorescent lights which are turned on most of the time. If you are sensitive to light, ask us to turn off those close to the windows. Certain events may include triggering visuals (flickering lights, etc.) or sensitive topics - however, you will be informed in the event description. Smoking, including electronic cigarettes, is prohibited inside. You are free to smoke outside where the ashtray is. There is a gender-neutral bathroom with 2 doors. Sanitary products found in the bathroom are free to use. Water is free upon request. You can also purchase a lemonade or a non-alcoholic beer. There are armchairs and folding chairs available to sit in. If you need to stim - fidget, pace, and others - you are welcome here. For assistance or help with anything else, don't hesitate to ask our staff.

House rules

Be respectful to the artworks and others who want to enjoy it. One's freedom ends where another one's begins.

Don't assume anyone's pronouns.

Zero tolerance of racism, homophobia, transphobia, ableism, enbyphobia, xenophobia.
